

PREFACE

The 2015 ICOI – 9th International Conference of Organizational Innovation was held in Yogyakarta, Indonesia organized by Airlangga University. This conference has been established on a global basis. We received 202 submissions from 12 countries. Each submission was peer-reviewed by at least two anonymous reviewers and a total of 142 papers were accepted for presentation in the conference. Researchers from five continents of the world attended the meeting. Accepted papers were scheduled for presentation in 31 parallel sessions.
