

Dr. Endre Pap (1896-1991)

60 years ago an unique revolution happened in the history of European maize breeding: the first inbred maize hybrid named Mv 5 (Martonvásár No. 5) was bred in Martonvásár, at the Research Institute of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences. The hybrid, state registered in 1953, was an outstanding intellectual performance of Dr. Endre Pap. Maize breeding in Martonvásár developed innovatively in the subsequent decades and achieved persistent success both in the field of science and practical results.
