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ESM 3 – Daily activity rhythms of small mammals. Number of small mammal video-captures per hour (N/h; grey bars) in each 1 hour time slot in relation to mean temperature (°C; red line) at 5-10 cm depth in the ground. Blue background indicate time slot between sunset and sunrise. Data were reported for 4 sample areas (plot 2, 3, 4, 6) located in the Brenta Dolomites (46°12' N, 10°53' E), within the Adamello Brenta Nature Park (Trento Province, Central-Eastern Alps, Northern Italy).
